The Annual Meeting of the Galway Lake Campers' Association, Inc. will be held Saturday, July 13, 1991, at 7:30 PM in Ruback's Grove. If you are unable to attend, a Proxy is attached to this letter. Your Board of Directors has approved a Budget for 1991-199~~2~~² as follows:

Based on this, and on 475 members, the Board of Directors has recommended that the Membership Fee for 1991-1992 be \$160.00 per campsite. The majority of the membership have paid the Dam Tower Assessment of \$340 in full, and the remaining balance on the note to finance construction is \$37,000.

We are pleased to report that the lake level has returned to normal, and the amount of milfoil weed in the lake has been dramatically reduced. Our work is still not done, however, in that we will continue to work on maintaining water quality through the reduction of nutrients reaching the lake, and developing a sewage treatment system that will protect the lake from pollution. Dr. Bruce Rowell has completed his Environmental Assessment of the lake, and will present his report along with a number of recommendations at the Annual Meeting.

In order to simplify the voting procedure at the Annual Meeting, we are enclosing an updated Membership Application that will have to be completed and turned in to the Clerk before the meeting in order to obtain a Ballot to vote. If you are using the Proxy Form, the signed and completed Application must be returned along with it to the Clerk prior to the meeting. Please also remember that all regular assessments and special assessment fees must be paid in order for you to receive a Ballot. The only exception to this is for those that have opted for a 2 or 5-year payment option, offered last year.
