Based on this and a remaining balance in our accounts of \$25,000 divided by 450 active and current dues-paying members, your Board of Directors recommends that the membership fee for 1992-1993 be \$100.00 per campsite.

With the return of the milfoil last season, the lake level was dropped substantially to attempt to freeze out the new growth of milfoil. Fortunately, the lake level has returned to normal and we now have to be alert for any sightings of milfoil. If you find any milfoil growing anywhere in the lake, please report it to your Grove Director.

Although the lake water tests still show good constant quality, the nutrient level is still high. Needless to say, monitoring of the lake quality must continue and new methods developed and used to maintain and improve lake water quality. Your suggestions for lowering the nutrient level are solicited and will be carefully considered.

With the return of a full lake of water and reduced weeds, the Galway Lake Sailing Club is ready to provide a full season of sailing for all those campers who want to join in the fun. Please see the enclosed letter for details.
