Dear Campers,

We are experiencing a very dry year. We had the second driest April since 1892, and not much run-off. We hope to get some rain in the next few days so we can have a full lake to help us enjoy the season. The Board reviewed the policy for lake control and we believe it is a good one. We normally start the draw down November 1 and draw down to 17 feet. If we have a weed problem we go down to 14 feet to freeze out the weeds. In the early spring as soon as the ice goes out we close the gates.

The Board met and we have a tentative assessment per campsite of \$110. We are also investigating the possibility of setting up a capital reserve fund for future expensive capital improvements. This would keep down the high assessments otherwise necessary to raise a large amount of money in a short time if the need to fund an expensive capital project should arise.

Mrs Otto has retired as our clerk. Lois Seyse has taken over and the transition is going very smoothly with no problems. We wish the best for Mrs Otto and hope to see her at some of our meetings. Mrs. Otto is 94 years old, heading for at least a 100! We have some minutes taken by her dating back to 1937.

Following is the tentative budget for 1999-2000. If this budget is approved, the assessment per campsite would be the same as it was last year: \$110.
