Dear Campers,

In the light of last year's lower-than-normal lake level, the Board modified its procedure for lake control by raising the 17 foot draw down level to 18 feet about March 1, and then shutting the lower gate a few days before the ice went out. A full lake was attained on April 13.

The Board met and we have a tentative assessment per campsite of \$110. We have set up a capital reserve fund for future expensive capital improvements. This will keep down the high assessments otherwise necessary to raise a large amount of money in a short time if the need to fund an expensive capital project should arise.

Following is the tentative budget for 2000-2001. If this budget is approved, the assessment per campsite would be the same as it was the last two years: \$110.

Please remember to abide by all boating laws when operating a boat on the lake. Remember that a life preserver must be in the boat for each person on board. For your own sake they should be worn at all times you are in the boat. Boats with electric motors must be licensed. Identify your boats and rafts with your camp number and name, so if they go adrift you have a chance of getting them back. Please use the "catch and release" policy if you are fishing only for sport.

It is especially important that your camp number be at least 3 inches high and easily visible from the road so that Emergency Services can find you in case of a problem.


I have enclosed a copy of an abbreviated report from the Galway Lake Preservation Committee which addresses their key findings during the 1999
